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### OMBUDSMAN PRESENTED STUDY REPORT TO CHIEF MINISTER, SINDH

Mr. Ajaz Ali Khan, Provincial Ombudsman Sindh presented study report on "Assessment of Malnutrition (Stunting) in District Tharparkar" on 08.12.2022 to Chief Minister, Sindh Syed Murad Ali Shah. The key objectives of the study were to carry out in-depth analysis of the nutrition-specific programs in last five years in Tharparkar along with nutrition indicators, the dynamics of strengths, weaknesses, opportunities and threats (S.W.O.T) in the nutrition landscape to offer prescriptions for the improvement of nutrition outcomes in Sindh. The study was carried out by R&T wing of P&D Board from the Regional subsidy of International Ombudsman Institute.

The C.M. Sindh appreciated the efforts made by Ombudsman Sindh and has agreed for a launching ceremony in C.M. House, Karachi.

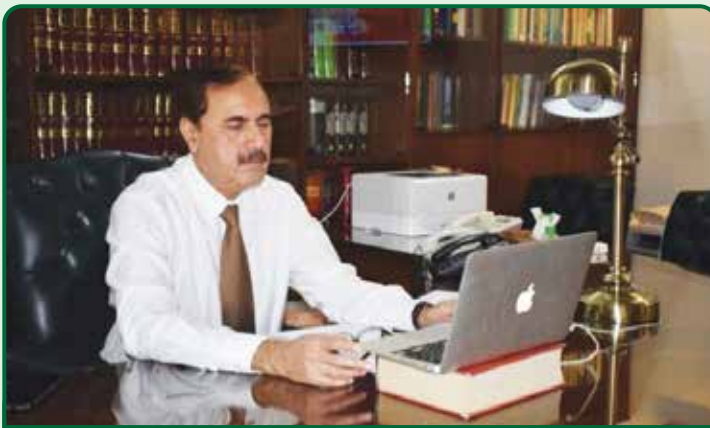

## **HIGHLIGHTS OF REDRESSAL OF PUBLIC GRIEVANCES**

### **WIDOW OF DECEASED CONSTABLE OF EXCISE DEPARTMENT GOT PENSIONARY BENEFITS AND HER SON GOT APPOINTMENT AGAINST DECEASED QUOTA**

The complainant Safia Bano wd/o ex-constable of Excise & Taxation Department persuaded the Excise and Taxation Department for almost 15 years for pensionary benefits and 12 years for the job of her son against deceased quota before approaching the Ombudsman Sindh in July, 2020. After detailed investigation and protracted correspondence by the Ombudsman Office the widow of deceased constable received an amount of Rs.1,213,684/- on account of financial assistance, G.P Fund, leave encashment, Group Insurance and family pension arrears. Besides, her son has also been appointed against deceased quota as Constable in Excise Department.

### **SON OF DECEASED APPOINTED IN SCHOOL EDUCATION DEPARTMENT**

Mr. Muhammad Umar s/o Late Allah Warayo Pathan R/o. District Ghotki, has been appointed as chowkidar against deceased quota in School Education & Literacy Department, Government of Sindh, after vigorous persuasion by office of Ombudsman of Sindh.

### **GROUP INSURANCE CLAIM PAID TO MST. NASEEM ROSHAN IN OPEN KATCHAHRY.**

On the directives of Mr. Ajaz Ali Khan, Provincial Ombudsman Sindh, an open Katchary was held by Mr. Ali Akbar Jagirani, Regional Director, Provincial Ombudsman, Sindh, Regional Office, Larkana on 16.11.2022 where complaints regarding delay in payment of dues towards group insurance claims, service benefits and salaries were submitted by various complainants. The District Accounts Officer Larkana was advised to ensure redressal of their grievances as per law without any further delay. Furthermore, the DAO Larkana was directed by Regional Director Larkana during Khuli Katchehry to process the pension case of Mst. Zareena Khatoon immediately.



Besides, cheque of Rs. 600,000/- on account of group insurance was delivered to Mst. Naseem Roshan.

### **NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF CARDIOVASCULAR DISEASE (NICVD) PAID RUPEES TWO MILLION AND APPOINTED SON OF THE COMPLAINANT AGAINST DECEASED QUOTA.**

Mrs. Rabia Fareed widow of Fareed Noor, an employee of NICVD in her complaint stated that she had received only Rs.0.5 million as death assistance package instead of Rs.2.5 million as per Finance Department Notification dated 09.10.2017 and her son was also not appointed against deceased quota. After intervention of Ombudsman Sindh, widow received remaining amount of Rupees Two million through pay order and also confirmed appointment of her son as helper BPS-01 against deceased quota.

### **IRRIGATION WATER PROBLEM RESOLVED BY PROVINCIAL OMBUDSMAN SINDH**

On the complaint made by Mr. Manzoor Hussain R/o, District Mirpurkhas for not getting proper share of irrigation water, the matter was taken up with Irrigation Department and was resolved by constructing temporary syphon under the technical assistance of Irrigation Department.

### **PROVINCIAL OMBUDSMAN SINDH GETS WIDOW HER DUE RIGHT DENIED BY THE AGENCY FOR 04 YEARS**

Mst. Madiha widow of Faizan Ali approached the Provincial Ombudsman Sindh Mr. Ajaz Ali Khan stating that the authorities concerned has refused to process her request for appointment in place of her deceased husband who served as Draftsman in the Office of Executive Engineer, Buildings Division, Hyderabad and died during service in July, 2018.

To redress grievance of the complainant, Ombudsman Sindh issued directives to the authorities concerned to initiate enquiry against the Officers / Officials responsible for delaying the matter. Due to intervention of the Ombudsman, process and procedure of scrutiny by the concerned departments were expedited and case of the complainant was sent to the District Recruitment Committee for verification and approval. Resultantly the committee found that complainant met the criteria laid down for appointment as Telephone Operator and was accordingly appointed enabling her to care for her kids.

The complainant appreciated and thanked the Ombudsman Sindh for her appointment against deceased quota after four years of death of her husband.



### **INFORMAL RESOLUTION U/S. 33 OF THE ACT.**

The Chairperson, School Management Committee, DMC Girls & Boys Elementary School No.19, Shah Abdul Latif Bhattai Road, near Kamela Stop UC-07, Lyari Karachi South, approached the Ombudsman, Sindh against Town Health Officer that students of the school were vaccinated for prevention of Covid-19 but their B-Forms / CNIC Numbers were not uploaded to NADRA website resultantly parents of the children were facing problems in getting NADRA certificate.

The matter was informally taken up with Health Department, Government of Sindh, under section 33 of the office of Ombudsman for the Province of Sindh Act 1991 (amended upto-date). In compliance, the District Health Officer (South), Karachi reported that record of vaccinated students has been updated on NADRA website which was randomly checked on covid helpline 1166 and the reply received, indicating that vaccination process done. The complainant also checked and thanked the Ombudsman Sindh for taking prompt action.



### **ILLEGAL BUSINESS OF ACID AND NICKEL POLISH IN RESIDENTIAL AREA REMOVED ON THE INTERVENTION OF PROVINCIAL OMBUDSMAN, SINDH.**

Dr. Muhammad Zahoor Qureshi filed a complaint against illegal business of acid & nickel polish by some private persons in residential compound of City Survey No.115/8, Qazi Abdul Qayoom Road, Hyderabad without any NOC/License of the relevant Agency.

The Deputy Director (Tech), EPA submitted report alongwith undertaking of owner of the company that the business would be shifted from residential area within one month. The Agency and the complainant during hearing confirmed stoppage of business in the residential area and latter thanked this Institution for saving the residents of the area from environmental hazard.



## **VISIT OF CIVIL HOSPITAL MITHI DISTRICT THARPARKAR**

Jam Farhat Baig S. Dahar, Regional Director, Provincial Ombudsman's Regional Office Tharparkar visited Civil Hospital, Mithi, where Dr. Zahid Mehmood Arain, Medical Superintendent briefed him that Mithi Civil Hospital established in 1993 was upgraded in the year 2014 from 50 beds to 174 beds with Generator and R.O. plant. It has 72 doctors, 188 para medical staff, 110 WMOs, 3 Dental Surgeons, 2 SMOs and 24 MOs. Regional Director observed that patients were attended properly in OPDs and general wards. The patients also confirmed provision of proper treatment with medicines.

The Medical Superintendent informed that death toll of minor children and pregnant women is due to malnutrition which is the outcome of poverty, early marriages and low birth spacing.



Mr. Akberally filed complaint regarding unjust delay in payment of medical bills on account of services provided by Liaquat National Hospital to the Lyari Development Authority (LDA). The complaint was admitted and after vigorous pursuation, the Agency produced cheque amounting to Rs. 415,036/- (being final installment) which was handed over to the complainant by the Regional Director, Karachi East.



A consultation workshop/meeting was held in Secretariate POS with Sindh Agricultural and Forestry Workers Coordinating organization (SAFWCO) when the participants / representatives of the NGO were explained about the complaints handling procedure.

- An act of maladministration on the part of SL&ED regarding the delay in appointment of Mr. Khalid, son of deceased primary school teacher was addressed by the Ombudsman Sindh as Mr. Khalid after ten years suffering got the job of chowkidar against deceased quota after completion of required formalities. The Secretary SE&LD was asked to avoid such inordinate delays in future.

- On a complaint filed by 95 dentists Sindh Ombudsman Ajaz Ali Khan directed the Principal of Karachi Medical and Dental College (KMDC) to pay Rs. 45,000/- monthly as stipends to each Bachelor of Dental Surgery (BDS) House Officers like MBBS doctors.

He also advised the Administrator KMC to release the funds required by the KMDC for payment of such stipend including arrears.

Besides, the ombudsman directed the Sindh Chief Secretary and Secretary, Local Government and Housing Town Planning Department, Sindh to expedite the process of release of funds and to take measures to end the discriminatory treatment with BDs House Officers on priority basis and to get rid of financial constraints faced by the college.

- Mr. Faheemuddin filed complaint regarding non-payment of arrears of special conveyance allowance. The complaint was admitted and notice issued to the Municipal Commissioner, DMC Korangi. After follow-up, the Agency submitted cheque dated 17.10.2022 amounting to Rs. 90,000/-, which was delivered to the complainant by the Regional Director, Karachi East.

- An amount of Rs. 29,98,042/- on account of financial assistance, G.P Fund, leave encashment and other pensionary benefits were paid to retired / widow and legal heirs of deceased government employees on intervention of Ombudsman Sindh. The recipients were Mst. Aneela wd/o of Mukhtiar Ahmed Abro (Rs. 400,000 -financial assistance), Mr. Akhtiar Ali Buriro, Rtd. ASI (Rs. 4,12,800/. leave encashment), Mr. Shoukat Ali (Rs.200,000/- financial assistance), Mr. Zafar Ali Gurjani (Rs. 390,218 and Rs. 15,95,02/- towards LPR and pension commutation).



Prof. Rtd. Atibar Ali Abbasi, received two cheques total amounting to Rs. 10,68,218/- from Registrar, POS on account of arrears / difference of his pension presented by Director Finance, Mehran University of Engineering and Technology Jamshoro.



Officers of POS attended two days online workshop on "The role of Integrated Computer Technologies in Public Grievance Redressal System" conducted by Federal Ombudsman Secretariate, Islamabad.

The Regional Director, Provincial Ombudsman Sindh, Hyderabad conducted a Seminar and Walk in collaboration with District Education Officer (Primary & Higher Secondary) Jamshoro, Sindh Education Foundation (SEF), Human Rights Youth Organization & NGOs/Civil Society at Directorate of Curriculum Assessment Research Jamshoro, Sindh, in connection with implementation of Recommendations of Study on the "Issues of Girls' Education in Sindh".



Ms. Rehana Ghulam Ali Memon, Consultant attended the National Working Women day celebrated on 22.12.2022 at Provincial Ombudsman Sindh for the Protection against Harassment of women at work place (PHWWP), Sindh. She shared her experience as working woman and also informed about the women friendly facilities such as toilets, prayer room etc, rare in government departments, are to be provided to the working women of Provincial Ombudsman Sindh. The event was attended by women from all walks of life.



On the intervention of Provincial Ombudsman Sindh, Mr. Abbas Khalid received Rs. 5.113 Million on account of service / retirement dues from Fisherman's Coop. Society Karachi. Syed Maqsood Haider, Regional Director, Provincial Ombudsman of Sindh, Regional Office, Karachi South handed over cheques of service dues to the complainant.

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**Moot urges parents to educate daughters**

LARKANA: Speakers at a seminar on girls' education said that a people who educated their girls would have educated mothers, who would in turn be instrumental in creating an entire nation of educated citizens.

They were speaking at the seminar titled "Importance and issues of girls' education" held in I.B. Khuroo High School under the aegis of Sindh Education Foundation on Monday evening.

Ali Akbar Jagirani, regional ombudsman of Larkana who presided over the programme, said that the programme about importance of girls' education had been launched to create awareness among people and it was being monitored by his office.

He said that a female was no less important in any way than her male counterpart in society hence, education for both was necessary because a civilised society required equal role of both sections of the population to achieve development and prosperity.

Prof Mukhtiar Ahmed Samo, writer and founder of Knowledge Centre, said that women could prove their mettle in all spheres of life if educated and trained properly. Otherwise, the society would be deprived of their talent and potential.

He said that society, home and government had to be streamlined to ensure quality girls' education. It was not only out of the home that girls faced challenges and harassment but even in many households their male members opposed their girls' education, he said, adding that the government must provide ample facilities for the provision of education to girls if it was serious to meet targets of female education.

Prof Abdul Wahheed Chandio, director of Private Schools Management, said that it was a misconception to believe that education was aimed at achievement of government service. "We have to make people understand that education is not meant for creating servants but producing well educated and trained citizens who could play a positive role in society," he said.

The main purpose of education was reformation of society and girls' education ensured well educated and trained females who could contribute effectively to the progress and wellbeing of society, he said.

Ahmed Ali Soomro, assistant commissioner, said that women and men were like two hands. "If the simple function of clapping cannot be done with one hand then how can societies achieve development by completely ignoring female section of population," he said, urging parents to send their girls to schools.

Mushtaque Soomro, regional director of Sindh Education Foundation Larkana, said that SEF had been endeavouring hard to make available educational facilities in backward areas and focusing on promotion of girls' education.

The speakers discussed in detail the issues of general inequality in education, out of school children, dropout challenges, dearth of secondary schools for girls, distance to schools, lack of amenities, lack of availability of female teachers and poverty.

Dr Rehana, Ms Anam Shaikh, principal of ZABTECH Larkana, Izhar Khokhar, Mohammad Saleh Khuroo and Junaid Dehar also spoke at the programme.

Students also delivered speeches and staged tableaux which highlighted issues being faced by girls in acquisition of education.

A science exhibition was also held on the sidelines of the seminar in which models depicting different concepts of science were put on display.
